



APPLICATION PROCEDURE FOR EUROPEAN, NON-EUROPEAN COUNTRIES AND WITHIN THE UTRECHT NETWORK STUDENT MOBILITY SCHEME

IT IS SIMPLE!

JUST FOLLOW TWO STEPS

Incoming students should demonstrate sufficient English language skills (at least B2 level)

STEP I

The International Relations Office (or equivalent) of a partner university nominates their students to the JU and send their nomination to JU coordinators of certain regions.

STEP II

Nominated students have to register at https://irk.uj.edu.pl/en-gb/ and complete the online application form. The application has to be printed, signed by the home university coordinator and uploaded to the system.



Important deadlines!

Winter semester: Make sure both steps are done by 31 May 2021

Summer semester: Make sure both steps are done by 30 November 2021

LIVING IN KRAKÓW

Housing:

Incoming students can stay at one of four JU well located student dorms, where the monthly cost for one person is ca. 450 PLN (100 EUR). The student is supposed to state if he is willing to stay in one of the dorms while filling the online form. Please bear in mind that the selection of the dorm is made by the JU International Students Office.

Public transport:

The cost of a student monthly ticket (tram & bus) is ca. 74 PLN (16 EUR). The Krakowska Karta Miejska (KKM) is a card for city transportation which you can buy in any MPK service point (for example at ul. Podwale 3/5) and extend its validity in any ticket machine.
