Authorization to Release Confidential Information

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) of 1974, and amendments pertaining thereto, is a federal law that protects the privacy of a student's education records. Education records are any records that contain information that is directly related to the student, and are maintained by the institution or a party acting on behalf of the institution. Under FERPA law, the Student Conduct Program may not share the contents of a student's conduct file with anyone other than the student, unless the student provides written consent to do so.
