The mission of the Utica College Intensive English Language Program is to develop the English language proficiency of English learners so that they are prepared for academic success in college study.

The IELP provides students the opportunity to develop English language proficiency through daily study, guided practice, and authentic academic tasks. The courses are designed to support high intermediate to advanced level non-native speakers of English in mastering the listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills necessary to make progress in an American college environment. Students are able to complete the program in one or two semesters, depending on their level of proficiency. The IELP requires 20 hours of class time per week. Four classes per level are required: Structure and Composition, Reading and Vocabulary, Listening and Note-taking, and Oral Communication. Students must also complete assignments outside of class.
