

First, add the “Panopto block” to your course.

Turn editing on, and scroll down in the left hand menu to "Add a block".

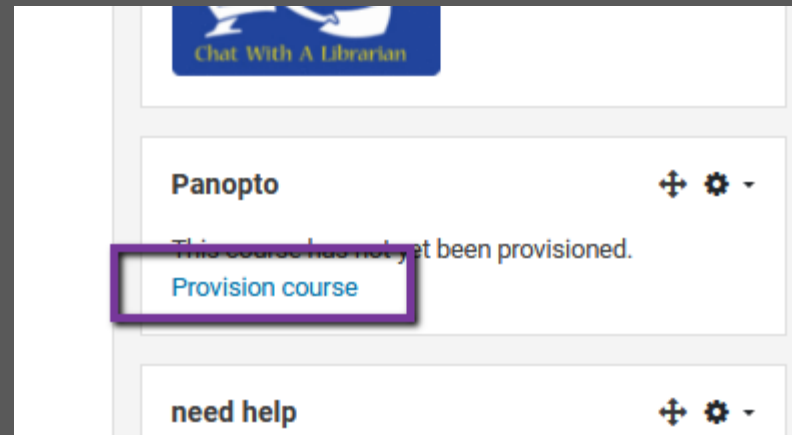
Look for "Panopto".

Find the “Panopto” block that you just added, and click to “Provision course”.

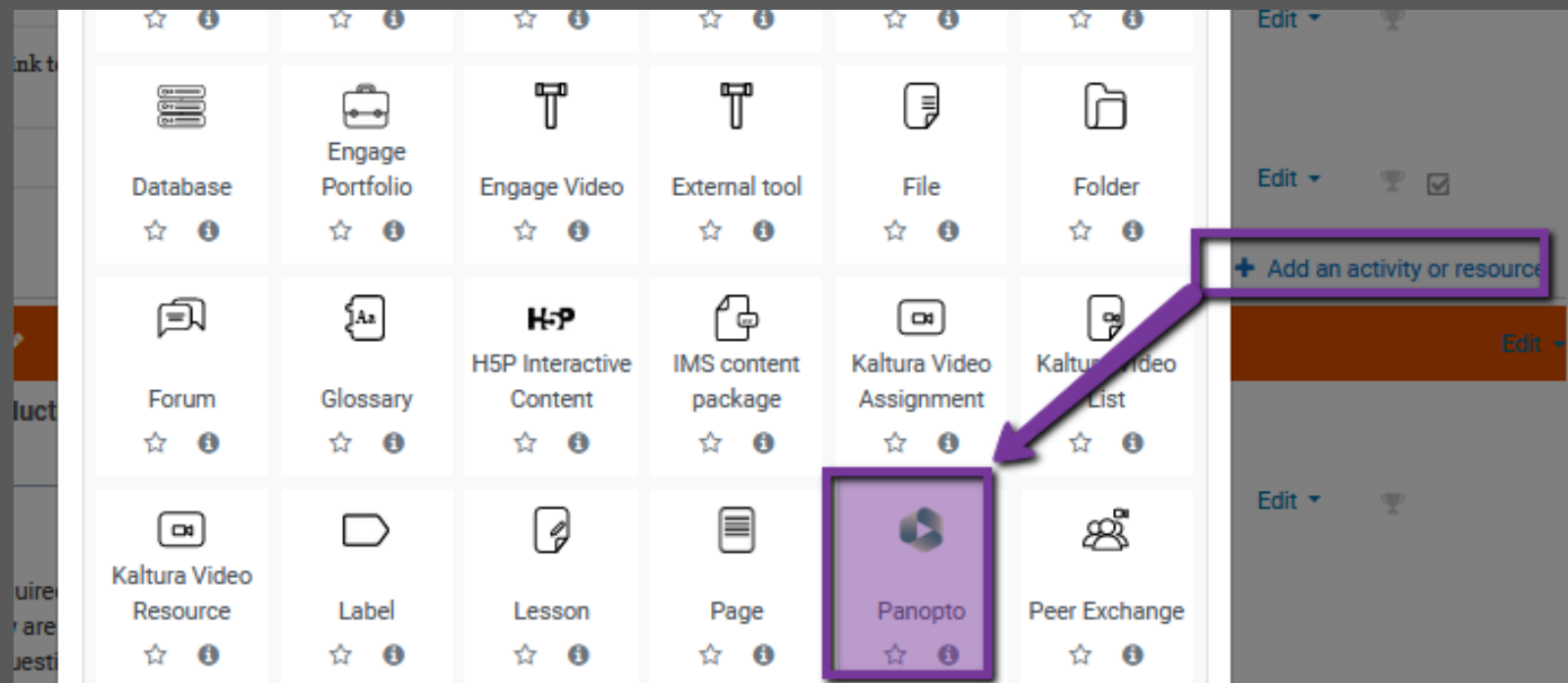
This will create a folder behind the scenes to organize media created for this course.

Select “Panopto”.



Add a name for the new Panopto object, and then save at the bottom.
