## **Points of Distinction for Education Programs**

- 1. Strong partnerships with area school districts for hands-on experience
- 2. Small class sizes with individual attention
- 3. Program evaluation aligned with NY State and National Standards
- 4. Students take education as a "linked major" with a major program of study
- 5. Students in education have two academic advisors: one for their "major" and one for education
- 6. Inclusive education faculty who teach both general education and special education courses
- 7. Opportunities to participate in Education Club and Kappa Delta Pi (Education Honor Society)
- 8. Collaborative professional development with area school districts to keep teachers current with education reform
