
Genocide, War Crimes and Crimes Against Humanity A Topical Digest of the Case Law of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia

The volume, which is available online and in print, is oriented to practitioners and staff at courts and tribunals established to try such crimes, as well as academics, students interested in international criminal justice and nongovernmental organizations working in the field.
