

Managing your retirement savings is getting easier

TIAA has added some enhancements to the retirement program to give you more flexibility when making contributions to your retirement account.

Starting today, November 9, 2020:

- Online salary deferral. Change your Utica College retirement plan contribution amount by logging in to your account at TIAA.org/utica. To help simplify the management of your account, you can go to the same place to make changes to your contribution and investment options.
- Self-directed auto increase. If you are participating in the plan, you may
 also elect to enroll in the self-directed automatic increase feature to help
 you build your savings even faster. To use this new feature, simply Log in
 to your account any time after November 9, 2020, and select *Change
 contribution amount* under the *Actions* menu. You can choose when you
 would like to automatically increase your contributions, the rate of the
 increase (percentage), and when you would like to start and stop the
 automatic increase.
