HOUSING DURING BREAKS

We recognize that as a Non-US student you may not have the option to travel away from UC during our Thanksgiving, Winter, and Spring breaks. We allow you to remain in your residential room during these breaks as long as you request permission through a Google Form that will be emailed out approximately one month in advance. Please note: campus dining services are not open during breaks.

END OF THE YEAR CLOSING

The last day of Finals for the Spring Semester is May 7, 2019. All international and exchange students must be moved out of the residence halls by Monday, May 13, 2019. This information is provided now so you can begin booking transportation home.

SUMMER HOUSING

UC does offer summer housing to students who may be taking summer courses, working locally in the area, or who are international and cannot travel home. Rates for summer housing and the registration process will be announced in the spring semester.

HOUSING REQUIREMENT

All first-year and second-year students are required to live-on campus. Please be advised that if you are a first-year student you will be required to live-on campus next year.

LIVING IN THE GLOBAL VILLAGE

If you are interested in living in the Global Village next year you will need to go through the Global Village Selection process. More information on this will be provided in the spring semester.
