HEAD COACH



ERIC STILZ

As the season closes, LeMoyne, Skidmore, RPI, Ithaca, Clarkson, RIT, Hartwick, Nazareth, Alfred University, and others will join Utica for competitions in the Upper New York State Swimming Association Championships as well as the New York State Women's Association Conference Championships.

Leading the women's program will be senior captains **Kelsey Schwilling** and **Danielle Andrew.** Schwilling finished 14th in the 100-fly at the NYSW-CAA championships and broke the team record in the 100-fly last season. Andrew is one of the hardest working ladies on the team and with her training, she has set an example for her teammates.

Sophomores **Nicole Bossler** and **Denice Goodrich** are coming off successful seasons as both will be needed to accomplish team goals, which is to improve times and produce high quality performances.

Coach Stilz has nothing but praises for senior diver **Rebecca Provost**, who finished 9th in 1-meter dive and 11th in 3-meter dive at the Empire 8 Championships.
